A special meeting of the Village Board held on the above date was called to order at 8:30 am in the Village Hall, 1 West Main Street, Clifton Springs, N.Y. 14432

Also present were Jim Tabor from Empire Emergency Apparatus, Alan Francese from Bristol Fire Equipment, Steve Gulvin and from Clifton Springs Fire Department Chief Lynn Spence, 1st Assistant Chief Will Slack and fireman Dan Delpriore.

This bid opening was properly advertised in THE DAILY MESSENGER on August 20, 2013.

Mayor Hunter called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. The purpose of this meeting was to open bids for the purchase of one new unused 2014 rescue pumper fire truck.

Mayor Hunter thanked those present for taking the time to submit a bid.

Bids were opened in the order they were received.

Bid #1

Churchville Fire Equipment, 340 Sanford Road South, Churchville NY 14428

Bid = \$343,922 for a Peirce Rescue Pumper

Bid #2

Bristol Fire Equipment, 6441 Montanye Road, Canandaigua, NY 14424

Base = \$350,567.44 for a Freightliner CFB Custom cab and body Rescue Pumper

Bid #3

Empire Emergency Apparatus, 3995 Lockport Road, Niagara Falls NY 14305

Base = \$339,653 for a Rosenbauer Rescue Pumper

It appeared all bidders submitted proper bid bonds.

The members from the Fire Department took all bids with them for review. Empire Emergency Apparatus of Niagara Falls NY appears to be the low bid. The Fire Department intends to have a recommendation for the Village Board for the regular Board meeting that will be held on October 14, 2013.

There being no further business to come before this Board motion was made by Trustee Linsner 2nd by Trustee Lincoln to close the bid opening and to adjourn at 8:40 am. All members present voting AYE.
